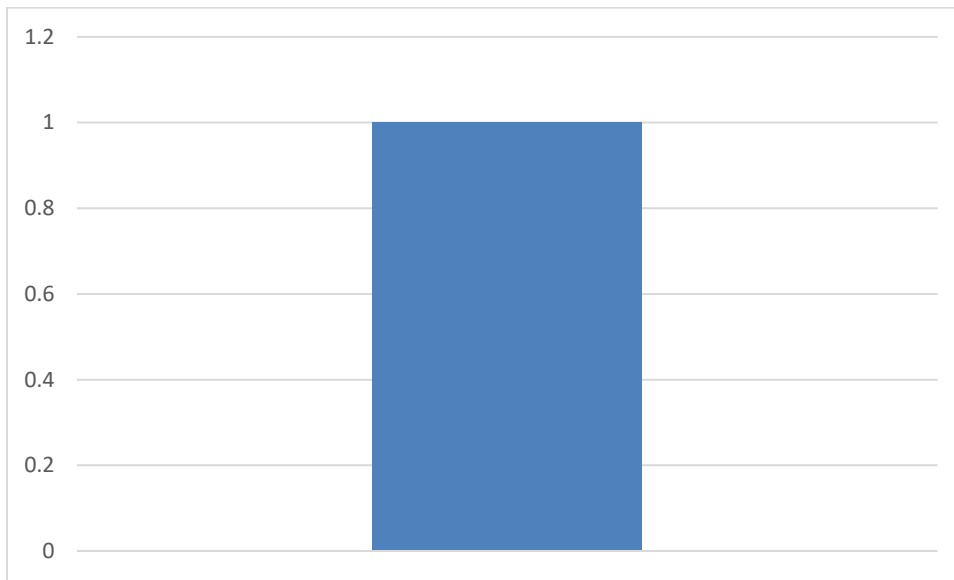


Figure: Relevance of E-resources, library and other facilities of the college for supporting and enhancing your learning experience.

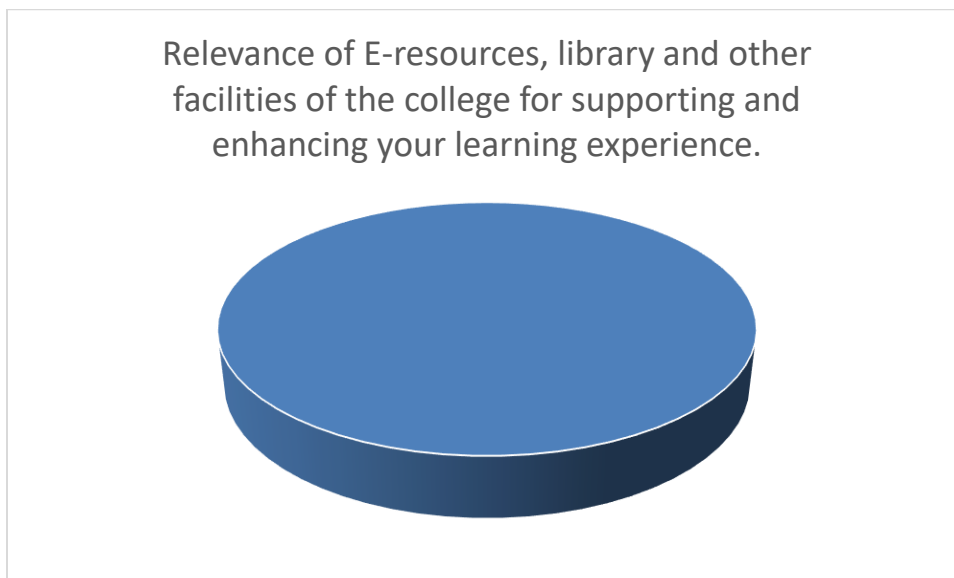
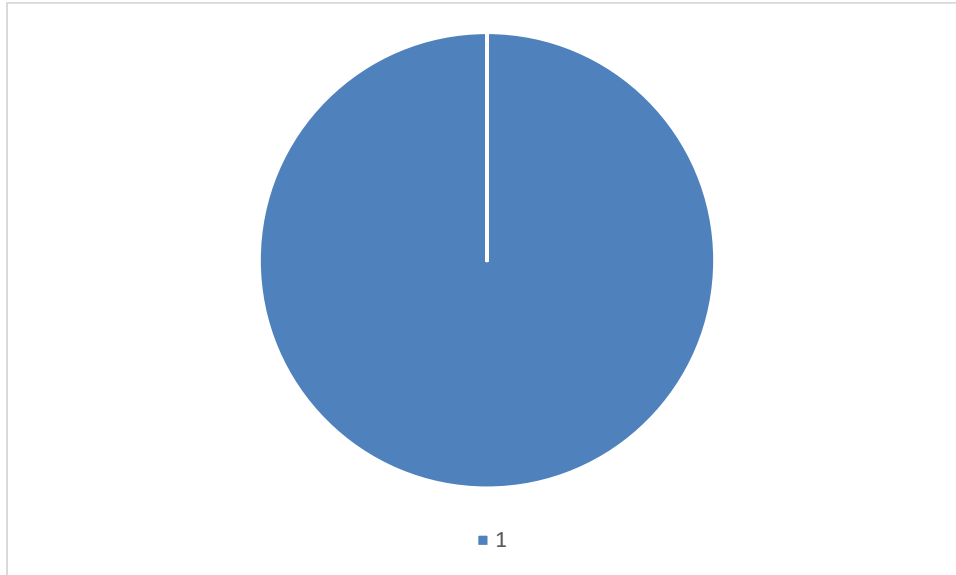


Figure: 1.3.3 Overall Experience and Reflection about the Curriculum

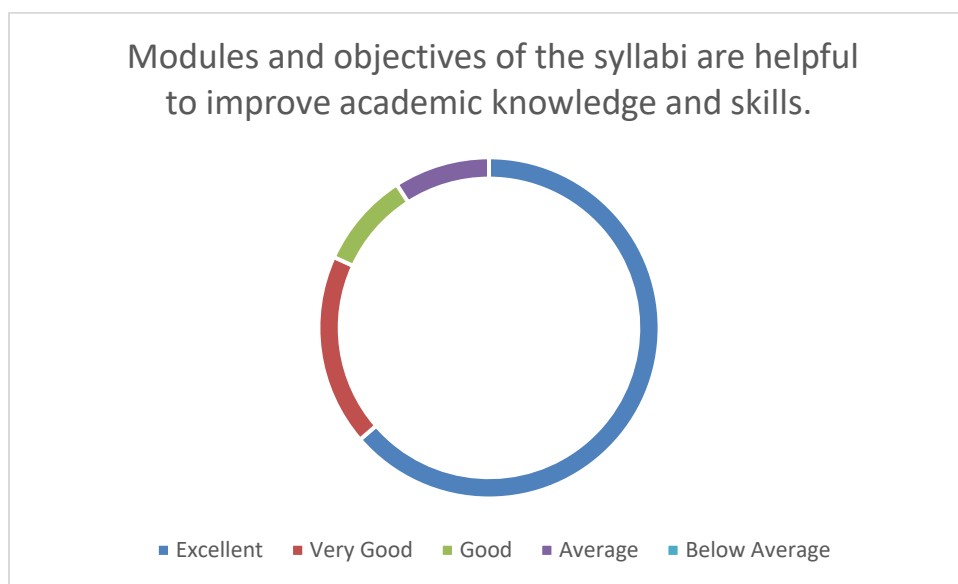
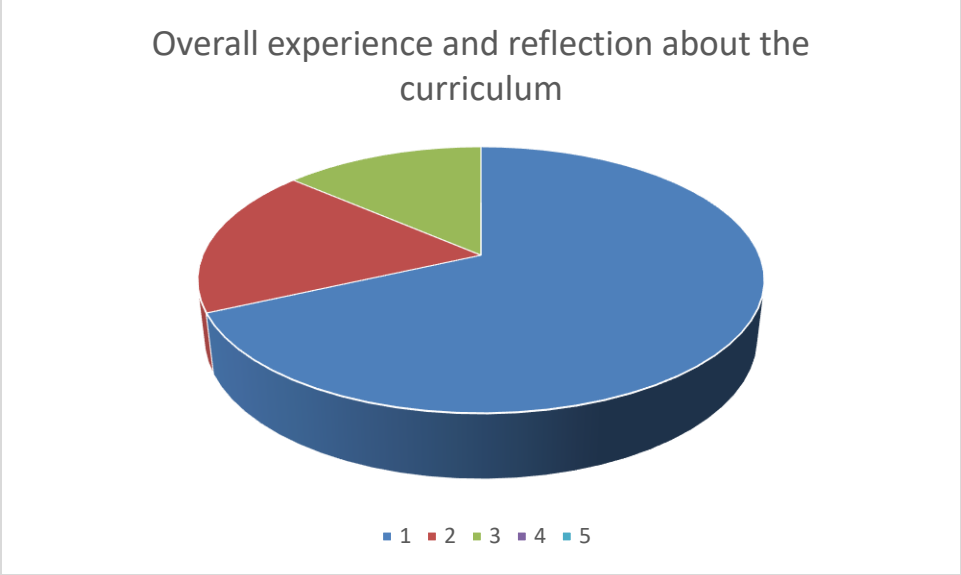


Figure: 1.3.1 Overall Experience and Reflection about the Curriculum
